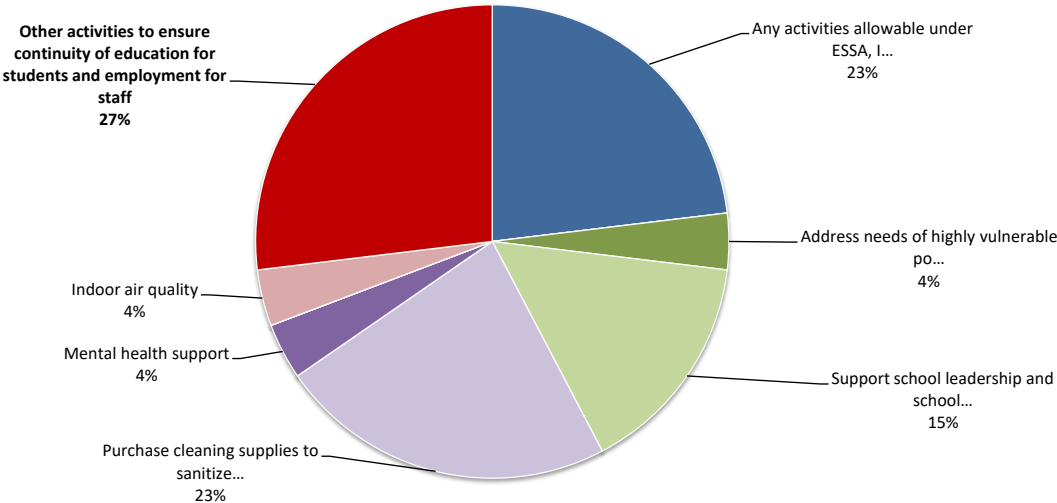
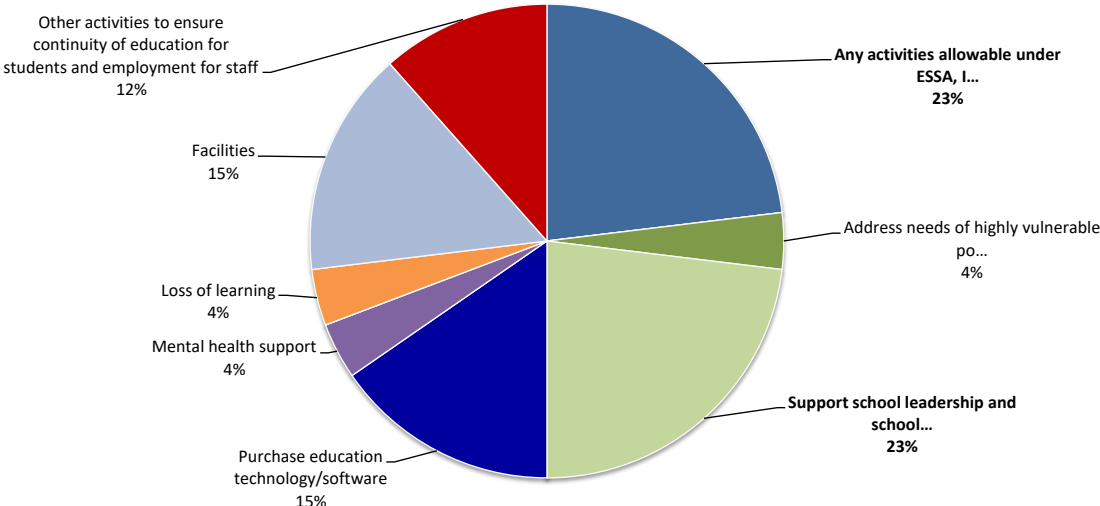


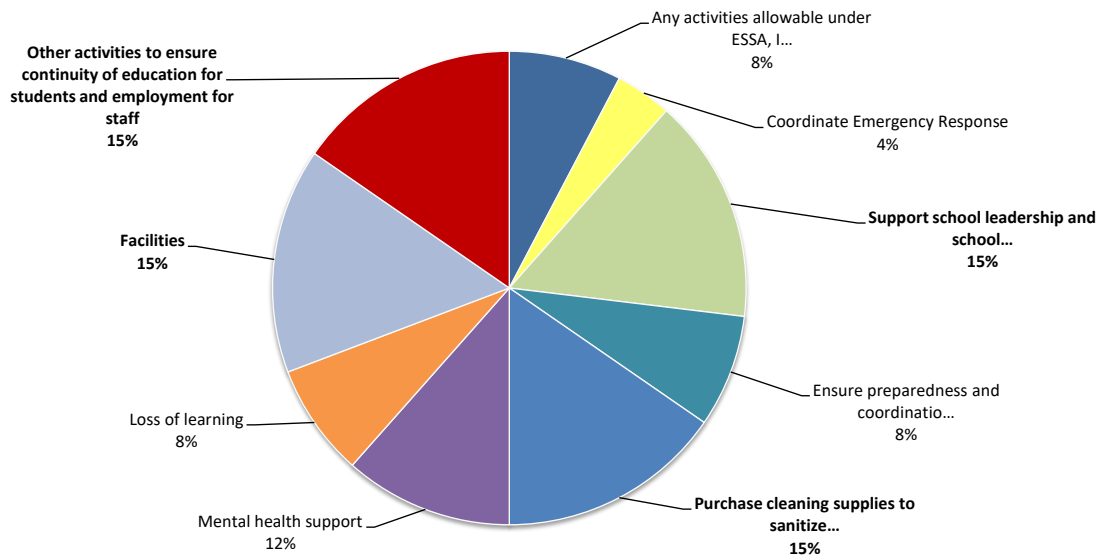

Other activities to ensure continuity of education for students and employment for staff.**



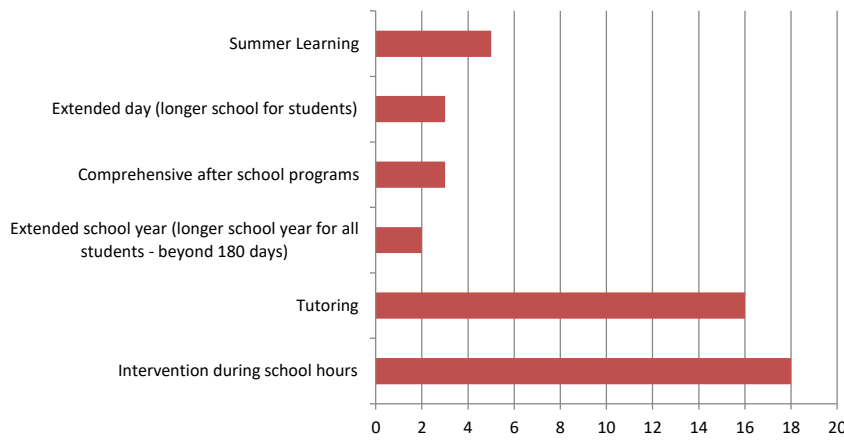
**Based on survey input, our Second Most important category is:
