The teachers have to buy their own instructional supplies. We had a TPT account but it expired in Feb. it would be nice to have it again. When the staff is buying basic things for the kids, there is a problem. Two cases of water a week isn't enough and we always run out.

Last year was a hard one, so teacher staff support is always recommended. It would be easier to do my job if I had white boards that erased.

Right now, the janitor and she gets a stipend. However, any support cleaning and keeping the facilities clean are needed. It's what gives kids pride in their school and what prospective students see when they tour with their parents. Last year she was also in charge of Saturday school for attendance and wasn't paid extra for that duty.
